SCHEMES UNDER AGRICULTURAL MARKETING AND AGRI BUSINESS DEPARTMENT

Scheme No. 1	Uzhavar Sandhais
Benefits offered	Uzhavar Sandhais (Farmers Market) for the benefit of farmers as well as consumers have been set up in the urban areas of Tamil Nadu. At present, 141 Uzhavar Sandhais are functioning in the State. Uzhavar Sandhais ensure the farmers to get better price for their produce and enable the consumers to get farm fresh commodities at a lesser price than in the open market.
Eligibility	Farmers cultivating vegetables and fruits possessing the Identity cards issued by the Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops.

Scheme No. 2	Immediate payment to farmers at Regulated Market
Benefits offered	The main objective of the Regulated Markets is ensuring immediate payment to the farmers for their agricultural produces sold. When the farmers agreed to sell their produce at the price quoted by the traders then the staff of the Regulated Markets ensure correct and immediate payment to the farmers before their produce taken away by the traders.
Eligibility	All farmers who sell their Agricultural Produce in the Regulated Markets.
Officer to be approached	Superintendent / Supervisor of Regulated Market
Time limit for sanction/ rejection	On the same day of declaration.
Appellate Authority	The Secretary, Market Committee.

Scheme No. 3	Pledge loan to farmers
Benefits offered	In order to avoid distress sale by the small and marginal farmers due to glut in Market during harvest seasons, Regulated Markets are issuing pledge loan to farmers. Under this scheme, the farmers can store their agricultural produce in the godowns of the Regulated Markets for a maximum period of 6 months and avail pledge loan of 75% of the total value of the produce upto the maximum of Rs.1,00,000. For the first 15 days there is no interest. Interest at the rate of 5% will be charged beyond 15 days.
Eligibility	All farmers who sell their Agricultural Produce in the Regulated Markets.
Officer to be approached	Superintendent / Supervisor of Regulated Market.
Time limit for sanction/ rejection	One week.
Appellate Authority	The Secretary, Market Committee.

Scheme No. 4	Pledge loan to traders
Benefits offered	As an encouragement to the traders to buy Agricultural Products through Regulated Markets and also to make the payment to the farmers immediately, pledge loan is extended to the traders in all Regulated Markets. Pledge loan of 50% of the purchase value upto the maximum ceiling of Rs.1.00 lakh is given to the licensed traders. Traders can stock their purchased agricultural produce in the regulated market itself for a maximum period of 3 months for which the interest rate is 9%.
Eligibility	Licensed traders who are trading in the Regulated Markets.

Time limit for sanction/ rejection	One week.

Scheme No. 5	Tamil Nadu Farmers Development and Welfare Scheme.
Benefits offered	The farmers / tenants who sell their agricultural produce one or more than one metric ton of their agricultural produce through Regulated Markets every year will be enrolled under this scheme and are eligible for a grant of a lumpsum amount up to Rs.1,00,000, in case of death / permanent disability occurring due to accident/ death due to snake bite, Rs.75,000 for loss of both the hands or both the legs or both the eyes due to accident, and Rs.50,000/- for losing one hand or one leg or one eye or permanent hip disability due to accident. The farmers need not pay any Premium for this grant. The Market Committee concerned and the Tamil Nadu State Agricultural Marketing Board will bear the contribution of Rs.10 per individual per year equally.
Eligibility	All farmers who sell one or more than one MT of their agricultural produce per year in the Regulated Markets.

Time limit for sanction/ rejection	The proposal should be submitted to Tamil Nadu State Agricultural Marketing Board, Chennai within 3 months of the accident/ death occurred.

Benefits offered	In order to help the consumer to get quality and
