Uttar Pradesh

Uttar Pradesh has unlimited potential for agro based and food processing industries. The state produces 38% of India's Wheat, 20% of Paddy 21% of Sugarcane, 34% of Groundnut, 17.5% of Rapeseed, 8% of fruits and 14% of vegetables. Uttar Pradesh is also the highest milk producer in India and thus offers excellent opportunities for setting-up milk processing units. Meat, Dairy, Sugar, Wheat and Horticulture based industries are other exciting avenues for food processing. Uttar Pradesh is also the largest market for seeds, fertilisers, farm credit, farm machinery and consumer products. The state government has also taken several initiatives to promote investment and catalyse the process of agriculture development.
