## About

The 17th IFOAM Organic World Congress will be carried out for the first time in Asia. The International Society of Organic Agriculture Research (ISOFAR) has supported the idea to bring this important event to the continent, where almost 60 % of the world's population live. High population densities and smallholder farms create a distinctive research context in particular for Organic Agriculture. ISOFAR welcomes papers on all aspects of Organic Agriculture and particularly calls for the submission of cross-disciplinary papers and issues related to the agricultural situation in Asia. The topic list includes disciplines related to, but not exclusively:

- Soil fertility
- Crop production
- Livestock husbandry
- Socioeconomics
- Food processing and marketing
- Food quality
- Natural resources and agro-ecology
- Research methodology, on-farm research and innovative knowledge transfer

## Joint conference of IFOAM and ISOFAR

The IFOAM World Congress will be a joint conference of IFOAM and ISOFAR both interested in bringing together the different stakeholders of Organic Agriculture. While IFOAM is mainly focussing on practical issues of the improvement

of the organic sector (System Value Track), ISOFAR seeks to promote and encourage a scientific approach to the various challenges in Organic Agriculture. The OWC research track is equivalent to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Scientific Conference of ISOFAR.

Papers for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Scientific Conference of ISOFAR will be evaluated by a peer review system. The programme will include oral presentations, guided poster tours and workshops. Acceptance of papers both for oral presentation and posters will be based on the relevance to Organic Agriculture, the contribution to the overall aims of ISOFAR, and scientific quality.

## Submission Procedure and Time Schedule

The submission procedure is a one step process. Papers have to be written using a mandatory template ([www.isofar.org/kowc2011/template](http://www.isofar.org/kowc2011/template)) and be submitted via the congress website: [www.ifoam.org/kowc2011](http://www.ifoam.org/kowc2011). Please make sure that you properly select the correct classification, i.e. research track.

Successful papers must fulfil the following requirements:

- maximum 4 pages (single-spaced)
- minimum 1400 words
- originality of the theme
- clear description of the objectives
- proper description of materials and methods
- short but concise overview on the results

Please supplement the paper by the preferred form of presentation, oral or poster and indicate under which topic is to be presented. However, the final decision in these matters is reserved for the Scientific Committee.

Papers will be reviewed by two referees following a peer review system. Authors will be informed by February 28, 2011 whether the paper is accepted. Accepted papers must be revised by 30 April 2011. The conference programme will be published on 30 June 2011.

## Conference Proceedings

The conference proceedings will include both papers from oral and poster presentations. Authors will receive a copy (maximum 2 per paper) free of charge at the conference. Electronic Proceedings (PDF) will be available for all ISOFAR members free of charge. Accepted papers will only be published in the conference proceedings if the conference fee has been paid in time.
