ABOUT NATIONAL GROUNDWATER CONFERENCE

Worldwide rapid growth of population, industries and agricultural activities brought about a steep increase in water demands, which have to be met from available surface and groundwater resources. Vagaries of monsoon and withdrawal of groundwater in excess to replenishment of aquifer system in many parts of India and elsewhere result into continuous declining of water table causing economic problems and deterioration of water quality. The problem is manifold in hard rock regions where the water table has gone below the weathered zone and it could be extracted only from deeper fractured zones. The aquifer systems in many hard rock areas have been over exploited. At many places, several farmers have drilled bore wells without knowing the potential of aguifer system and thereby end up with debt trap due to failure of the bore wells. Therefore, for the proper assessment, development and management of groundwater resources to over come, or at least minimize such problems a necessity was felt for suitable interaction among researchers, practicing hydrologists, planners and water users.

The Ministry of Water Resources, Government of India has declared the year 2013 as "Water Conservation Year" due to the increasing demand of water for various purposes viz., domestic, irrigation and industry. It has been reported that drinking water need is going to rise by 44 per cent, irrigation need by 10 per cent, industry need by 81 per cent respectively by 2025. Hence there is a need for greater awareness on water conservation for optimal usage of the existing resources.

In this context a **National Groundwater Conference** (NGWC-2013) is being organized by Water Technology Centre, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore during December 9 -11, 2013 with the main focal theme on "Problems, Challenges and Management of Groundwater in Agriculture". It is also proposed to have a number of farming community representatives and NGO's as registered delegates in the proposed conference enabling them to interact directly with National Water/ Agricultural/ Environmental Scientists and Engineers.
