

THIRTY FIRST ANNUAL WORKSHOP - ICAR - AICRP ON POST HARVEST ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY



The 31st Annual Workshop of the All India Coordinated Research Project on Post Harvest Engineering and Technology (PHET) was organized by the Department of Food and Agricultural Process Engineering, Agricultural Engineering College and Research Institute, TNAU, Coimbatore from 4th to 6th January, 2016. The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. K. Ramasamy, Vice Chancellor, TNAU, Dr. K. Alagusundaram, DDG (Engineering), ICAR Chaired the Inaugural function. Dr. S. N. Jha, ADG (PE), Dr. R. K. Gupta, Director, ICAR - CIPHET, Ludhiana, Dr. C. Divakar Durairaj, Dean, AEC & RI, TNAU and Dr. M. Maheswaran, Director of Research were also present. Workshop on Priorities and Functional Modalities for Implementing Agroforestry Policy - 2014



A consultative workshop on Setting up Priorities and Functional Modalities for Implementing Agroforestry Policy - 2014 was organized in the Forest College and Research Institute, Mettupalayam on 10th-11th December, 2015, in which scientists, representatives from rural industries, wood based industries, farmers, farmer producer organizations and NGOs numbering 150 participated.

Dr. K.Ramasamy, Vice Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University inaugurated the workshop and emphasized in his inaugural Address, the major role to be played by agroforestry in the future economic development of the country. He called upon the Scientists to devise projects considering the limitations and constraints faced by farmers practicing agroforestry.

Mr. Venketeshwara Rao, Chief General Manager, NABARD, delivered the Special Address and called upon the participants to discuss different guidelines provided in the agroforestry policy and come out with practically applicable recommendations to benefit farmers and other stake - holders. Dr. S. Balaji, I.F.S. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Research and Education), Tamil Nadu Forest Department in his Chief Guest Address opined that farmers would practise agroforestry only when they are assured of better returns. He stressed the need to develop a market price mechanism for agroforestry and emphasized to implement the activities pertaining to


