Farmer's Day 2018 at TNAU



'Farmer's Day' 2018 was held at TNAU, Coimbatore between 9th and 10th February, 2018. Field demonstration of farm technologies, seminars on frontier areas of agriculture with 65 exhibition stalls were arranged for the benefit of farmers. Dr. H. Philip, Director of Extension Education, delivered welcome address. Dr. K. Ramasamy, Vice Chancellor, TNAU delivered the presidential address. Thiru R. Duraikannu, the Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture delivered the inaugural address and released Eight new crop varieties viz., Rice - ADT 51, Cowpea - VBN 3, Groundnut -TMV 14, Sunflower - COH 3, Sugarcane -COG 6, Sugarcane - CO 06022, Ribbed gourd - COH 1 and Malai Vembu - MTP 2. The Agriculture Minister distributed the seed bags to selected farmers and distributed awards to 14 farmers. Five farmers received the Velan Chammal Award sponsored by CRI Pumps, three farmers received the Best Seed

Producers Award, three farmers received the Best Innovative Award and two farmers secured the Best Women Farmer Award. One Farmer Producer company was given with the Best Farmer Producer Company Award.
