Nanotechnology instruments Hub equipped with BET Surface Area and Pore Size Analyzer

BET (Brunauer, Emmett and Teller) Surface Area and Pore Size Analyzer, a high-quality, highperformance gas sorption analyzer with two multi-station models is installed in nano materials research laboratory. It is a fully automated, vacuum volumetric gas adsorption analyzer for measurement of single and multipoint BET



surface area, pore volume and pore size distribution of powdered and porous nano materials. It has a compact, bench-top design with built-in degas capabilities with wide variety of sample cells to accommodate any sample. It can perform automatic analysis including real time display of isotherm data and BET computations and Perform instrument operations locally (via touch-screen) or remotely (via Ethernet-linked PC). It is highly useful for the scientists and students of the University.
