#### General Advisory:

Extended range Forecast for next week (28th June to 11th July 2024):

## Rainfall:

As per extended range predictions, there is possibility of below normal rainfall likely over the district during 28<sup>th</sup> June to 04<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

As per extended range predictions, there is possibility of slightly above normal rainfall likely over the district during  $5^{th}$  to  $11^{th}$  July 2024.

#### **Maximum Temperature:**

Maximum temperatures are likely to be near normal and are likely to be in the range 26°C to 34°C over the plains of the district during next week. 28<sup>th</sup> June to 04<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

Maximum temperatures are likely to be generally normal and are likely to be in the range 26°C to 32°C over the plains of the district during next week. 5<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

### **Minimum Temperature:**

Minimum temperatures are likely to be near normal and are likely to be in the range 20°C to 24°C over the district during next week 28<sup>th</sup> June to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

# Weather Based Agro-Advisories: (Bitter ground, Bhendi & Animal Husbandry) Bitter ground:

To increase the number of female flowers in the cucurbits vine, Spray Ethrel @100 ppm (1 ml in 10 lit of water) four times, from 10 to 15 days after sowing at weekly intervals.

Ensure the availability of sufficient moisture in the field, before spraying.

#### **Bhendi:**

The incense of Red cotton bug noticed in Bhendi. Infested seeds become discoloured and shrivelled.

To manage this, conserve the biocontrol agent Harpactor costalis predaceous on nymph and adults and spray Beaveria Bassiana @ 600ml per acre.

### **Animal Husbandry:**

Due to the prevailing weather condition, Enterotoxaemia disease may affect the Goats. The main symptom of the disease causes sudden death in young growing kids. Mucous diarrhoea may also be seen during death.

To prevent this disease, do not feed on young grass, allow the goat for grazing one hour after the sunshine. Immediately contact the nearest veterinary clinic and vaccinate your animals.
