

# Extended range Forecast for next week (14<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024):

### **Rainfall:**

As per extended range predictions, there is possibility of near normal rainfall likely over the district during 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

As per extended range predictions, there is possibility of below normal rainfall likely over the district during 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

# Maximum Temperature:

Maximum temperatures are likely to be near normal and are likely to be in the range 32°C to 36°C over the plains of the district during next week. 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

Maximum temperatures are likely to be near normal to slightly above normal and are likely to be in the range 34°C to 38°C over the plains of the district during next week. 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

## Minimum Temperature:

Minimum temperatures are likely to be near normal and are likely to be in the range 24°C to 28°C over the district during next week 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

Minimum temperatures are likely to be near normal to slightly above normal and are likely to be in the range 24°C to 28°C over the district during next week 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

# Weather Based Agro-Advisories: (Bhendi, Jasmine & Animal Husbandry) Bhendi:

Boron deficiency is noticed in the Bhendi fields. The symptoms are the fruits become small in size and malformed.

A foliar spray of Borax @ 3.5gm with 0.5ml of wetting agent in 1 litre of water is recommended to manage the boron deficiency.

Spraying activities should be carried out only on the non-raining days.

### Jasmine:

Manganese deficiency symptoms are noticed in some Jasmine fields. The symptoms are leaves showing yellowish green background with fine nature of green veins and interveinal chlorosis of leaves.

To overcome this deficiency, soil application of MnSO4 @ 5 to 10 gms per plant or Foliar spray of MnSO4 0.5% at fortnightly intervals is recommended.

### Animal Husbandry:

Kind attention to the livestock-rearing farmers, there are chances of occurrence of Foot and Mouth disease in cows during this season.

Farmers are advised to prevent the cows from Foot and Mouth disease, by vaccinating your cows at the government veterinary clinics during the month of June.

Vaccination should be done once in every 4 months.
