# **General Advisory:**

# Extended range Forecast for next week (21<sup>st</sup> June to 04<sup>th</sup> July 2024):

#### **Rainfall:**

As per extended range predictions, there is possibility of near normal to slightly above normal rainfall likely over the district during 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

As per extended range predictions, there is possibility of generally normal to slightly above normal rainfall likely over the district during 28<sup>th</sup> Jun to 04<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

# Maximum Temperature:

Maximum temperatures are likely to be near normal and are likely to be in the range 36°C to 36°C over the plains of the district during next week. 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

Maximum temperatures are likely to be near normal to slightly above normal and are likely to be in the range 36°C to 36°C over the plains of the district during next week. 28<sup>th</sup> Jun to 04<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

#### Minimum Temperature:

Minimum temperatures are likely to be near normal to slightly above normal and are likely to be in the range 24°C to 28°C over the district during next week 21<sup>st</sup> Jun to 04<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

#### Agriculture:

Since some amount of rainfall has been received recently, and rainfall is expected for the coming days, farmers can plan for ploughing and land preparation activities.

Farmers are also advised to act swiftly to repair the water channels, farm ponds and other water bodies to harvest the rainwater.

Postpone the spraying activities for a short while.

# Weather Based Agro-Advisories: (Tapioca, Groundnut & Animal Husbandry)

#### Tapioca:

Tapioca cultivating farmers are advised to give general recommendations of urea @ 39 kg and murate of potash @ 80 kg per acre as top dress within 90 days after planting of tapioca.

#### Groundnut:

To increase the flower retention and pod filling in Groundnut, Farmers are advised to give two sprays of Groundnut rich @ 5kg/ha in 500 litres of water (for each spray).

First spray can be given, at 35 days after sowing and the second spray at 45 days after sowing.

#### Animal Husbandry:

To increase the SNF rate in cow milk, farmers are advised to add 2 to 3 grams of baking soda and 15 to 20gms of cooking salt with the routine daily feed of cows, this will help to increase the SNF rate in the milk.
