Past Weather for Tamil Nadu District

Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 047 (11.06.2024) for Tamil Nadu. Maximum temperature ranged from 32°C to 39°C and minimum temperature ranged from 23°C to 28°C, over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 17°C to 21°C and minimum temperature ranged from 13°C to 14°C. During this period occurred rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Erode District Past Weather

In Erode district, during 11.06.2024 to 13.06.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 29°C to 33°C the minimum temperature was 23°C to 25°C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 86 per cent and evening relative humidity was 75 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 13-24 km per hour and the wind direction were from East direction.
