Weather Summary/Alert:

As per District level forecast issued by the IMD for Nilgiris district, sky will be generally cloudy to cloudy. Very light rainfall is expected for first two day, moderate rainfall is expected for Next three day. Maximum temperature will be around 13- 16°C. Minimum temperature will be around 10-13°C. Morning relative humidity will be around 90% and evening relative humidity will be around 70-80%. Wind speed is to be around 08 -10 km per hour.

General Advisory:

Very light rainfall is expected for first two day, moderate rainfall is expected for Next three day, hence vegetable farmers are requested to drain the excess water in vegetable field by making proper drainage facility.

SMS Advisory:

i) Provide drainage facility. ii) Postpone the intercultural / plant protection activities like fertilizer and pesticide application, till the rain stops.
