Past Weather for Tamil Nadu District

Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 039 (14.05.2024) for Tamil Nadu. Maximum temperature ranged from 35°C to 39°C and minimum temperature ranged from 23°C to 28°C, over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 19°C to 23°C and minimum temperature ranged from 12°C to 14°C. During this period occurred rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Coimbatore District Past Weather

In Coimbatore district, during 14.05.2024 to 16.05.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded was 34°C to 36°C the minimum temperature was 23°C to 24°C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 87 per cent and evening relative humidity was 50 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 6-17 km per hour and the wind direction were from East direction.

		done, since rain is anticipated.					
Sugarcane	Vegetative	Considering the local circulation due to increased temperature and					
		expected summer rains, provide propping to the sugarcane by tying					
		opposite row to prevent from lodging.					
		With the receipt of rainfall, late season sugarcane setts may be planted					
		with proper drainage.					

Banana		Considering the local circulation due to increased temperature and expected summer rains, provide propping to the banana of more than five months old to prevent from lodging.
Turmeric	Sowing	By utilizing rainfall, dibbling in turmeric rhizomes may be continued by providing proper drainage.
Tapioca		By utilizing the received and anticipated rainfall harvest may be programmed in Tapioca.
Grapes		For monsoon crop of grapes, pruning may be done since weather is favourable for this operation
Coconut		Summer rains during next two months may be harvested in root zone of coconut by deepening the tree basin with inward slopes. Till then, ensure to provide 100 liters of water per tree per day to maintain the productivity.
Animal Husbandry		Rain is expected during this week. Check the roofs of animal shed and repair leakages.

Continuous rainfall is predicted. Postpone irrigation, sowing, pesticide spray and fertilizer application.
