Perambalur District Past Weather

In Perambalur district, during 22.04.2025 and 24.04.2025 the Maximum temperature was recorded 39 °C the minimum temperature was 27 - 28 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 74 per cent and evening relative humidity was 39 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 11 - 12 km per hour and the wind directions were from south east direction.

Weather Summary for Perambalur district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, sky will be clear. Light drizzling expected on 28.04.2025. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 39 - 40 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 28 - 29 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 30 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 12 - 14 km per hour and the wind directions will be from south south east direction.

Agro Advisory

General		Since temperature is increasing, apply mulches to conserve soil moisture.
Rice	Nursery	Rice varieties ADT 53, ADT 56, ADT 57 and ADT 59 are suitable for summer season.
Pulses	Sowing	Farmers are advised to go for summer irrigated pulse cultivation during this Chithirapattam (April-May). Suitable varieties in blackgram are ADT 5, VBN 5, VBN 6, VBN 8 and in greengram are VBN 2 and VBN 3.
	Harvest	Harvest the matured blackgram and greengram plants and sundry the harvested pulses and store at below 9% moisture.
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.
Cattle	Cow and Goat	Calves above 3 months and sheep and goat above 2 months should be vaccinated against Foot and Mouth disease
		Due to increase in day temperature, grazing of Sheep and Goats should be avoided in hot hours of the day.
