### Mayiladuthurai District Past Weather

In Mayiladuthurai district, during 12.05.2026 to 14.05.2026 the Maximum temperature was recorded 32 - 34 °C the minimum temperature was 26 - 27 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 95 per cent and evening relative humidity was 88 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 4 - 8 km per hour and the wind directions were from south east direction.

### Weather Summary for Mayiladuthurai district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Mayiladuthurai district, sky will be cloudy. Light to moderate rainfall expected on 16.05.2026 to 20.05.2026. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 27 - 30 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 23 - 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 100 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 90 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8 - 12 km per hour and the wind directions will be from south south west direction.

### Agro Advisory

<b>General</b>		Postpone/avoid irrigation to all crops depending upon rain condition.
		Link the drainage channel with farm ponds towards efficient water drainage besides the rain water storage.
<b>Rice</b>	<b>Main Filed</b>	Prevailing weather condition is suitable for weeding and hence first hand weeding can be given on 20 to 25 days after transplanting.
<b>Banana</b>		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.
<b>Cattle</b>	<b>Cow and Goat</b>	Calves above 3 months and sheep and goat above 2 months should be vaccinated against Foot and Mouth disease
