### Perambalur District Past Weather

In Perambalur district, during 19.05.2026 to 21.05.2026 the Maximum temperature was recorded 37 - 38 °C the minimum temperature was 27 - 28 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 69 per cent and evening relative humidity was 54 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 10 - 22 km per hour and the wind directions were from south direction.

### Weather Summary for Perambalur district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, sky will be cloudy. Light rainfall expected on 23.05.2026 to 27.05.2026. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 37 - 38 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 27 - 28 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 75 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 55 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 4 km per hour and the wind directions will be from west direction.

### Agro Advisory

<b>General</b>		Postpone/avoid irrigation to all crops depending upon rain condition.
		Link the drainage channel with farm ponds towards efficient water drainage besides the rain water storage.
<b>Rice</b>	<b>Main Filed</b>	Prevailing weather condition is suitable for weeding and hence first hand weeding can be given on 20 to 25 days after transplanting.
<b>Banana</b>		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.
<b>Cattle</b>	<b>Cow and Goat</b>	Calves above 3 months and sheep and goat above 2 months should be vaccinated against Foot and Mouth disease
