1. BACKGROUND

Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU), a century old premier institute providing Higher Education in Agriculture. TNAU had its genesis from establishment of an Agricultural School at Saidapet, Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India as early as 1868 which was later relocated at Coimbatore during 1906. In 1920, the College was affiliated to the University of Madras with the introduction of a three-year degree programme. Till 1946, the Agricultural College and Research Institute, Coimbatore was the only institute for agricultural education for the whole of South India. In 1958, it was recognized as a Postgraduate Centre for offering Masters and Doctoral degrees. It is a non-profit public higher education institution. In 1971, TNAU was formed as separate and First Agricultural University of Tamil Nadu.

TNAU has the pride of being the first State Agricultural University (SAU) to be accredited by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). Recognizing the merits, the ICAR awarded "Sardar Patel Outstanding ICAR Institution Award 2021" under Agricultural University category and "Institute of Excellence Award 2021" and 8th FICCI Higher Education Excellence Awards 2022 to this institute. Overall, TNAU has secured National level 8th rank adjudged by ICAR for the year 2020. Among SAUs, TNAU stands 4th at the National level and 2nd among the Southern Agricultural Universities for this year.

TNAU stands 301-350 in QS Asia University Ranking, 351-400 rank in QS World University Ranking by Subject (Agriculture & Forestry) during 2021 respectively and 65th position in QS India Ranking for the year 2023. The ICAR has accredited Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore for a period of five years *i.e.* up to 31st March 2023.

Postgraduate study in TNAU is a very special experience. This Postgraduate Center has now spread over 11 campuses across Tamil Nadu with 792 highly postgraduate teachers under five faculties catering the aspirations of over 1439 scholars every year. Besides luring the talents from India, this postgraduate school is the favorite choice for international students owing to its cosmopolitan ambience, safe campus, and hub of international collaborative research projects in agriculture. The students on completion of the course requirements could take up their research in any institute / industry in India as per the existing norms. As an established research-intensive university, TNAU has excellent link with reputed national and international institutes for student exchange programme.

The pattern of instruction is choice-based credit semester system with thesis research being an essential part of all post graduate programs.

5. MINIMUM ACADEMIC REQUIREMENT:

Master's degree (Regular)	Two years (four semesters)
Doctoral Degree (Regular)	Three years (six semesters)

6. **ELIGIBILITY FOR MASTERS / DOCTORAL PROGRAMS:**

6.1 Only those students who have studied in State Agricultural Universities (SAUs)/
Colleges affiliated to SAUs/ Central Agricultural Universities (CAUs)/ ICAR Deemed
Universities/ Central Universities with Agriculture Faculty listed by ICAR/ any other
institutes accredited by NAEAB (ICAR) alone are eligible for admission to TNAU for
Masters & Doctoral programs.

6.2. MINIMUM OGPA /AGGREGATE REQUIREMENT:

Masters Program: A candidate who has undergone course credit system with a minimum OGPA of 3.00 out of 4.00 or 6.60 out of 10.00 in Bachelor's Degree Programme can apply for Masters Programme. However, for SC/ST candidates, minimum OGPA of 6.50 out of 10.00 in bachelor's degree is sufficient.

6.3 DBT Supported GAT- B M.Sc. (Ag.) in Molecular Biology & Biotechnology Program

6.3.1 Eligibility

- Qualified through GAT-B 2023 Exam conducted by Regional Centre for Biotechnology, Faridabad, Uttar Pradesh.
- B.Sc. (Ag.) / B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture/ B.Sc. (Hort.) / B.Sc. (Hons) Horticulture / B.Sc. (Forestry) / B.Sc. (Hons) Forestry/ B.Sc. (Sericulture)/ B.Sc. (Hons) Sericulture / B.Sc. (Ag.) Biotechnology/ B.Tech. (Hort.) / B.Tech. (Ag. Biotech.) / B.Tech. (Bioinformatics).
- Only those students who have studied (10+2+4 pattern of education) in State Agricultural Universities (SAUs)/ Colleges affiliated to SAUs/ ICAR Deemed Universities/Central Universities with Agriculture Faculty listed by ICAR/ any other institutes accredited by NAEAB (ICAR) alone are eligible for admission to TNAU.
- A candidate who has undergone course credit system with a minimum OGPA of 3.00 out of 4.00 or 6.60 out of 10.00 (70 in case of percentage) in Bachelor's Degree Programme can apply for Masters Programme. However, for SC/ST candidates, minimum OGPA of 6.50 out of 10.00 in Bachelor's degree is sufficient.

6.3.2 Mode of Application

• Students who qualified the GAT-B Entrance Examination can apply separately. Selected candidates will be admitted separately as per University Norms.

6.3.3 Mode of Selection

- Students selected under DBT, GoI sponsored program will be allotted to the Department of Plant Biotechnology, Centre for Plant Molecular Biology and Biotechnology, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore and AC & RI, Madurai.
- Students applying for DBT supported GAT-B M.Sc. (Ag.) Molecular Biology &
 Biotechnology Program <u>need NOT appear for TNAU Common PG Entrance</u>
 <u>Examination</u> conducted by the School of Post Graduate Studies, TNAU, Coimbatore.
- 20 seats will be reserved for the candidates qualified and selected through GAT B
 Entrance Examination conducted by Regional Centre for Biotechnology, Faridabad,
 Uttar Pradesh for this current academic year. The reservation policy for the GAT-B
 selection will be followed subject to the approval by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

DOCTORAL PROGRAMS:

A minimum OGPA of 7.00 out of 10.00 in Masters Programs is eligibility to apply for Doctoral Programme.

- 6.4. Masters program: Graduates who have successfully completed four-year undergraduate degree program (specified below) and awarded by any one of the State Agricultural Universities (SAUs)/ Colleges affiliated to SAUs/Central Agricultural Universities (CAUs)/ ICAR Deemed Universities/ Central Universities with Agriculture Faculty listed by ICAR/ any other institutes accredited by NAEAB (ICAR) alone are eligible to apply for Masters program.
- **6.5. Doctoral programs:** Candidates who have successfully completed four-year undergraduate degree program and two-year Masters program (specified below) and awarded by any one of the State Agricultural Universities (SAUs)/ Colleges affiliated to SAUs/ Central Agricultural Universities (CAUs)/ ICAR Deemed Universities/ Central Universities with Agriculture Faculty listed by ICAR/ any other institutes accredited by NAEAB (ICAR) alone are eligible to apply for the doctoral program.

7.1. A candidate shall apply for <u>only three subjects</u> in Master programs. <u>Separate fee is</u> <u>to be remitted for each subject.</u> Candidates seeking admission to Ph.D. can apply for only one subject.

- 7.2. All applicants should fill in the applications by **ONLINE ONLY** (https://admissionsatpgschool.tnau.ac.in/) till **12.00** midnight on or before **15.05.2023** for Masters and Doctoral programs.

- iii. SC/ST candidates from other states should also upload scanned copy of the community certificate issued by competent authority. BCM / MBC/ SCA Students of Tamil Nadu should upload the scanned copy of the community certificate.
- iv. The candidates seeking admission against differently abled set apart for Hearing impaired /Orthopedically Differently Abled / Visually Impaired should produce the recent certificate from the Medical Board of the District concerned certifying the nature and extent of disability in percentage. Certificates obtained from an individual Doctor will not be considered and such applications will be summarily rejected. Further, a separate TNAU Medical Team will examine the candidates with reference to their certificates and his/her suitability for admission to TNAU (Refer: Appendix-I)
- v. A scanned copy of provisional / degree certificate showing the Class or OGPA obtained in the qualifying degree.
- vi. Scanned copies of mark list / transcript card showing details of courses undergone and marks obtained in the qualifying degree.
- vii. While submitting the applications by online, if required scanned copies (documents) are not uploaded, then the application will be summarily rejected without any intimation.
- 7.3. All enquiries regarding admission process should be made only through e-mail at pgadmission@tnau.ac.in

8. METHOD OF SELECTION

For all Masters / Doctoral programs

- 8.1. Entrance examination will be conducted by **PHYSICAL** Mode only.
- 8.2. Candidates are required to be present on the specified date and time for the entrance exam/ written test on their own expenses at TNAU, Coimbatore. Request for change in the date/time will not be entertained.
- 8.3. The exact date and time of entrance exam will be published in the University website and intimated to the candidate through email.
- 8.4. Entrance test with multiple choice questions from the respective subjects will be for one hour duration. Candidates applied for three subjects should appear in the examination for all the subjects continuously.

Eligible candidates will write the entrance test for 100 marks in three compartments.



8.5. General Instructions for Entrance Test are as follows.

- 1. A valid photo I.D proof in original is required for entering entrance hall. Candidates arriving late by more than half an hour from the start of the examination will not be permitted to write the test.
- 2. Calculator, log tables, pager, mobile phone/Bluetooth devices or any electronic gadget, notebook or written notes, pamphlets, slide rules, protractors, rulers, highlighters, dictionary, electronic watches etc. are not allowed inside the Examination Hall. Any violation would amount to disqualification of candidature.
- Any candidate, who creates disturbance of any kind during the Test or otherwise misbehaves in or around the Examination Centre or changes his/her seat with any candidate will be expelled from the Exam Hall and it amounts to disqualification of the candidate.
- 4. Any candidate having in his/her possession or accessible to him/her papers/books or notes which may possibly be for providing assistance or copying from any paper/book or note or allowing any other candidate to copy from his/her answer sheet or found writing on any other paper, or using or attempting to use any other unfair means will be expelled from the Exam Hall.
- 5. The decision of the university to expel a candidate from the examination centre will be final.
- If a candidate puts any identification mark on the Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) sheet, the same is liable for cancellation. The decision of the University in this regard will be final.
- 7. If impersonation in the Entrance Test is detected, the candidature will be cancelled and a case will be registered with the police.

8.5. INSTRUCTIONS FOR ANSWERING THROUGH OMR SHEET

- 1. Read the instructions carefully given on the question paper.
- 2. Write your registration number only in the space provided on the question paper and OMR sheet (Refer APPENDIX II) and nowhere else.
- 3. The candidates are required to follow the correct procedure while answering the question paper. Shade the circle pertaining to the most appropriate answer on the OMR sheet with black ball point pen. If more than one circle is shaded, the answer will be treated as wrong. Incorrect marking will also be taken as wrong answer. For example, if you think that the answer given against choice (B) for question number 1 is the most appropriate answer, then shade the circle (B) given against 1.



- 4. Do not use any other mark except shading the circle.
- 5. The candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall within the first 45 minutes of start of the examination.
- 6. There will be no re-evaluation of the answer sheets.
- 7. Candidates must bring two ball point pens of black color.
- 8.6. All the original certificates for which scanned copies have been uploaded while filling online application should be submitted during admission without fail. Candidates who fail to upload certificates will not be allowed to appear in the entrance test and the application will be rejected.
- 8.7. Candidates should upload Provisional Certificate or Degree certificate or Course Completion from Registrar/ authorized signatory before appearing for the masters / doctoral entrance examination or at least the successful completion of viva-voce certificate for applying to Ph.D. programme from the Dean SPGS for TNAU students and for other state students, Head of the Institution (Registrar/Controller of Examinations/Dean of the university) without which they will not be permitted to appear in the examination. The decision of the chairman of the admission committee is final in this regard.
- 8.8. Allotment of students to the constituent colleges (for course and thesis work) of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University will be first based on the merit besides students'

- preference. The decision of the University will be final in this regard. Any recommendations shall be viewed seriously.
- 8.9. Submission of Degree Certificate/ Provisional Degree Certificate is must at the time of admission. Failing which, the candidature will be cancelled even if he/she has passed the TNAU Entrance Examination.

8.10. RESERVATIONS

8.10.1. The reservations will be followed as per the orders of the Government of Tamil Nadu in vogue at the time of admission.

Tamil Nadu Ordinance No. 4 of 2007 published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 262 dt. 15.09.2007 provides for reservation in respect of annual permitted strength in each branch or faculty for admission into educational institutions in the State including private educational institutions. For the Backward Class Muslims it shall be three and a half percent within the thirty percent reservation for Backward Class as provided in the 1994 Act and in 2006 Act.

- 8.10.2. Five percent of the seats of the M.Sc. / M.Tech. and Ph.D degree programme are reserved for differently abled candidates (Hearing impaired; Orthopaedically Differently abled and Visually impaired).
- 8.10.3. Two seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Jammu and Kashmir over and above the sanctioned strength. Students of the other states can apply under Open Competition (OC) only. However, SC / ST candidates from other states will be considered under respective categories on production of SC / ST certificate.
- 8.11. Depending on the availability of scientists and priority areas of research as per the TNAU/TN Govt. Policies, additional 20% seats will be allotted to wait listed candidates based on merit under self-supporting mode, if necessary (for Tamil Nadu candidates). The decision of the University for allotment of the candidates under Self Supporting mode will be final. In any case, allotment of students from one state (other than Tamil Nadu) will not exceed 40%.
- 8.12. Maximum of 20 percent seats of sanctioned strength will be allotted as supernumerary based on merit under self-supporting mode to the other state candidates (other than Tamil Nadu).

9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 9.1. The candidate will be informed of their selection for admission to P.G. programme by email or SMS only. List of selected candidates will be hosted on the University website also. University will not be held for any responsibility for failure in delivery of e-mails or SMS. The selected candidate should pay the prescribed fee on or before the date specified by the Dean, School of Post Graduate Studies, failing which their names will be removed from the selection list and the resultant vacancies will be filled up from the wait list.
- 9.2. The following original documents must be surrendered at the time of admission and failure to surrender any of the documents will make the candidates ineligible for admission.
 - 1. Provisional / Degree certificate of Bachelor's program for admission to Masters degree program.
 - Provisional / Degree certificate of Masters program for admission to Doctoral degree program
 - 3. Transfer / Migration certificate
 - 4. Conduct certificates: one from the Head of the Institution and two from the Professors of the Institution where the candidate last studied.
 - 5. Mark list/transcript card of Bachelor's/Master's degree as the case may be.
 - The original community certificate issued by the competent Revenue authorities should be produced for verification. An attested copy of original community certificate should be submitted for record.
 - 7. A copy of the online fee payment receipt.
- 9.3. Candidates who have paid the fee should register their courses on the date specified or within seven working days (inclusive of Saturdays) from the commencement of semester failing which the candidates will have to forfeit their admission.
- 9.4. Selected candidates who pay the fee on the notified date but fail to register on the specified date or fail to inform within seven working days from the date specified for registration are liable to forfeit all fee paid.
- 9.5. Candidates who discontinue after admission (or) registering the courses are not eligible for refund of any other fees except caution money deposit.
- 9.6. The original certificates surrendered at the time of admission will not be returned to the candidate till the course is completed or the candidate discontinue the course permanently. Hence, sufficient number of copies of all the original certificates (Grade/Mark sheet/report cards/ transfer/ conduct/provisional degree certificates) and scanned copies of the originals should be taken by the candidates before surrendering the originals to the University.

10. INTIMATION OF ENTRANCE TEST/SELECTION/ADMISSION

All communications regarding entrance test / selection / admission will be notified only by **e-mail or SMS** and hence, candidates are requested to provide e-mail ID and mobile number compulsorily and check their e-mails and SMS daily. Important dates/ Notification will be hosted on TNAU website.

11. HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

Limited hostel facilities are available. The University will provide accommodation to the extent possible. Students cannot claim hostel accommodation as a matter of right on their admission to PG programme. University reserves the right to provide/deny hostel accommodation to the students.

12. DISPUTE REDRESSAL

With regard to the interpretation of the provisions of any matter not covered in this Information brochure, the decision of the University shall be final and binding on all the parties concerned. Any complaints, grievances etc., related to PG Admission 2023 - 24 and academic matters must be first referred to the Dean, School of Post Graduate Studies, Coimbatore who will be the appellate authority with respect to such complaints/disputes. The Courts having their jurisdiction at Coimbatore alone can adjudicate on all matters and disputes related to PG Admission 2023 - 24 and academic matters.
