TNAU field day on “Frontline Demonstration in Chickpea”

A field day on “Frontline Demonstration in Chickpea” was organized by the Department of Pulses, Centre for Plant Breeding and Genetics, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore under the All India Co-ordinated Research Project on Chickpea at Udumalpet, Tiruppurdistricton 23.02.2024.

Dr. G.Senthilraja, Assistant Professor (Plant Pathology) welcomed the farmers to the field day.
