Selection of Scientist-B (Precoccon) in CSB from TNAU

Central Silk Board (CSB), the organization involved in research and development of sericulture activities in India has conducted the recruitment process for the selection of Scientist-B (Precocoon) to fill up 122 existing vacancies in the various research institutes located allover India.

The selection process comprised two phases. First, the Post-graduates with relevant subject appeared for the preliminary written test conducted by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi. Next, upon successfully clearing the examination, the candidates applied for the post of Scientist-B in CSB. The shortlisted candidates were called for the verification of original certificates and other documents at the ratio of 1:4. This was followed by personal interview which held from 03.06.2025 to 19.06.2025 at Central Office, CSB, Bangalore. The final result was released by CSB in their official website on 25.06.2025.

The result showed that out of 24 Sericulture and Forestry graduates of FC&RI attended, 17 including 15 Sericulture and 2 Forestry graduates were selected for the post of Scientist-B (Precocoon).

It is learnt from the successful candidates that the hands-on exposures imparted in mulberry cultivation, pests and disease management, disinfection, chawki maintenance, silkworm rearing, mounting and value addition during the practical classes and in-depth knowledge inculcated during the course work helped a lot to clear the written examination and face the personal interview with full of confidence.

Six post-graduates of Sericulture were selected for the post of Scientist-B in CSB in the recruitment conducted during 2023 and now working across India. In addition to this, a good number of Sericulture graduates are working as Inspector of Sericulture (IS) and Assistant Inspector of Sericulture (AIS) in State Sericulture Department, as Probationary officer (PO) and Agricultural Field Officer (AFO) in nationalized banks.

The B.Sc. (Hons) Sericulture graduates can appear in various competitive examinations viz., UPSC, TNPSC, SSC, RRB and Banking. They can also become the entrepreneurs by establishing sapling production unit, Chawki rearing centre, commercial cocoon production unit, and cocoon craft production unit.
