TAMIL NADU AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY & ANNAMALAI UNIVERSITY (FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE)

In the 2025-26 academic year, for the undergraduate programs, students will be admitted through a common online application for Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and Annamalai University (Faculty of Agriculture). At TNAU, admissions will be done for 14 undergraduate programs and 3 diploma programs. Admission for three UG programs will be done at Annamalai University (Faculty of Agriculture).

Application charges

The application fee for general BC, BCM and MBC/DNC students is Rs. 600/- for SC, SCA, and ST it is Rs. 300/-

Online application process

The online application admission process is comprised of the following steps: online registration, application filling, the release of the rank list, online counseling, seat allotment, certificate verification, upward movement (sliding), provisional seat allotment, certificate verification and submission. A. Tamil Nadu Agricultural University

A.1. Undergraduate Admissions 2025-2026

Tamil Nadu Agricultural University one of the premier Agricultural Institutes of India commences its undergraduate admission process for the academic year 2025-2026 from the day of (+2) result declaration. The admission will be made for the twelve (14) Undergraduate degree programs for the 18 Constituent Colleges and 28 Affiliated Colleges.

The Undergraduate degree programs offered in Tamil Nadu Agricultural University are, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture (Tamil medium), B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture (Tamil medium), B.Sc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Sc. (Hons.) Food, Nutrition and Dietetics, B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering), B.Sc. (Hons.) Sericulture, B.Tech. (Food Technology), B.Tech. (Biotechnology), B.Tech. (Energy and Environmental Engineering), B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri-Business Management, B.Tech. (Bioinformatics), and B.Tech. (Agricultural Information Technology).

The entire admission process is online. For all the fourteen UG degree programs, only one online application is required. In this academic year, 3370 candidates in Constituent colleges and 4405 students in Affiliated private colleges will be admitted (Annexure-I).

Admission will also be done for Eminent Sports person - 1 seat/ 1 government college (Total: 20 Nos), Differently Abled (5% of the sanctioned strength in government college: 128 Nos), Ex-serviceman - 1 seat/ 1 government college (Total: 20 Nos), 7.5% government school studied student quota (Total: 403 Nos), Vocational Stream (5% of the sanctioned strength: 223 Nos)

Admission for a few supernumerary quotas like ICAR (20%) of sanctioned strength, Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Agri-8; Horti-5, Total: 13 Nos), Study in India (32 Nos), and J&K (4 Nos) will also be done.
