**TNAU conducts Job Fair 2026**

The Centre for Students Welfare, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU), Coimbatore, organizes the TNAU Job Fair 2026 for Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Ph.D. students of Agriculture, Horticulture, Agricultural Engineering, Forestry and Sericulture from all the constituent colleges of TNAU on June 23 and 24, 2026, at main campus, TNAU, Coimbatore. The inaugural function was held at Anna Auditorium on 23 June 2026.

Welcoming the gathering, Dr. G. Balasubramanian, Dean, Centre for Students Welfare, urged the students to make the best use of the opportunities offered through this massive placement initiative. Dr. C. Babu, Dean (SPGS), Dr. P. Rajkumar, Dean (Agricultural Engineering), Dr.K.Venkatesan, Dean (Horticulture), and Dr. N.
